Guidelines for Preparation of Abstracts

The abstract for oral and poster presentation should be submitted on one single-sided A4 sheet with font size '12p', font type 'Times new roman' and a maximum word count of 500. Special characters and abbreviations should be avoided.

Please submit structured abstracts in the following format:

- Title of the abstract
- Presenter(s), Author(s), affiliations (University/Department) and Address, email & contact No(s)
- Introduction – Foundation for research, Research question and objective(s) of the study
- Material and methods
- Results
- Conclusion
- Acknowledgements of Funding (if any)
